



In 2005 a group of local residents committed themselves to an ambitious plan – to build a local wind farm that would benefit the entire community. The farm would take responsibility for a significant part of the local community's emissions as well as send a signal that our community was not prepared to wait for decisive action on climate change.

The wind farm is under construction in Leonards Hill, on the outskirts of Daylesford. With only two turbines, the wind farm is one of the country's smallest. The project has been deliberately sized to match the domestic electricity consumption of Daylesford and much of the surrounding area.

Almost 1600 members have raised over \$8.7m. As a community co-operative, Hepburn Wind is determined to ensure that the entire community, beyond its members, will benefit from the project. The project's Community Sustainability Fund is expected to provide more than \$1m over 25 years to projects that contribute to the social, environmental and economic sustainability of our local area.
