Harvesting the wind

It's been a little over six weeks since we started generation and already the wind farm has generated more than one gigawatt hour of electricity, that's more electricity than 200 average Victorian households use in an entire year. Not bad given that our output is currently capped to 60% and the turbines were on and off during the commissioning phase.

We'll be publishing more detailed data on our website in the coming weeks.

Did you know...

The Hepburn Community Wind Farm has almost 1900 owners – at last count 54% were local, and since the turbines went up, local membership has outpaced others two-to-one.

Thank you for showing Australia that under the right conditions, renewable energy projects can receive overwhelming support in their host communities.

All intellectual property created by the project is being 'open-sourced' so that other communities may benefit from the learnings. Our project has inspired the creation of Embark, a non-profit peak body working to extend the Hepburn Model to other communities. Embark has heard from more than 50 communities since last October
