# Second pour at wind site

HEPBURN Wind members celebrated the laying of an important foundation last week.

The final concrete foundation at the Leonards Hill community wind park was poured, opening the way for the park's two turbines to go up.

Project officer Tracy Anthony said 280 cubic metres of concrete was used in each foundation,

mostly sourced from Daylesford's East Street Boral plant.

She said the completion of the second foundation opened the way for the next step in the construction process to commence. "It's a milestone because we've waited so long for this to happen," Ms Anthony said. "We know the next step is actually the

turbines being raised."

The two REpower 2.05mW wind turbines are expected to arrive at Leonards Hill in early March with completion on track for June or July.

Ms Anthony said construction of Australia's first community owned wind farm was on track for completion in June or July.

## Tribute for Allan Hall

MEMBERS of the Daylesford RSL last week paid tribute to their former president Allan Hall, who died suddenly on Thursday after collapsing behind the RSL bar where he worked as a volunteer.

Mr Hall, 62, served as president of the Daylesford sub-branch from April 2009 to April 2010.

He died at the club on Thursday afternoon after a heart attack.

Current president Neil Chamberlain described his predecessor as "a popular figure" who

would be missed at the club.

"Everyone is extremely shocked," he said. "He has given service on the committee, including his year as president and he has been a regular volunteer to help out behind the bar."

"During his time as president he contributed to the development of the RSL for the benefit of the RSL members."

He carried out the tradition of the RSL in an excellent fashion."
