Noise monitoring

Late last year, Marshall Day Acoustics completed a round of noise monitoring. (A final round will be offered once our power constraint is lifted by Powercor.) The report is being reviewed by Hepburn Shire Council and will soon be shared with local residents and the public.

The monitoring indicates that the wind farm is compliant with the relevant standards, however we understand that some people still hold concerns about our monitoring program. To help address these concerns we have approached the EPA and requested that they audit the program and the report.

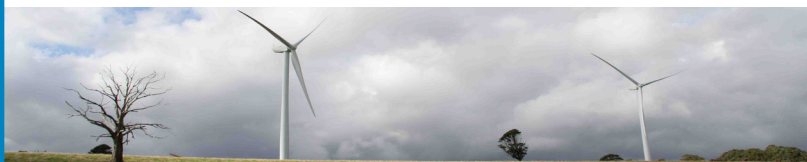
Did you know?

You may occasionally notice that one or both of the turbines are not generating despite plenty of wind. During December and into January we have been required to shut down several times while Powercor performs scheduled maintenance elsewhere in their network. Our turbines have also been offline recently for their six month service.

There can also be unscheduled outages during storms and temporary equipment issues. Despite these outages and the variability of the wind, Gale and Gusto were generating at a level 90% of the month of December.
